

LINEN CLOSET CHECKLIST

BED LINENS

- Fitted Sheets: 2 sets per bed (1 on the bed, 1 in the closet)
- Flat Sheets: 2 sets per bed (1 on the bed, 1 in the closet)
- Pillowcases: 4 per pillow (2 on the bed, 2 in the closet)
- Pillow Shams: 2 sets per bed (optional)
- Duvet Covers: 2 per duvet (1 on the bed, 1 in the closet)
- Blankets: 2 per bed (1 on the bed, 1 in the closet)
- Quilts/Comforters: 2 per bed (1 on the bed, 1 in the closet)

TOWELS

- Bath Towels: 2 per person
- Hand Towels: 2 per person
- Washcloths: 2-3 per person
- Beach Towels: 1-2 per person (adjust based on frequency of beach outings)

TABLE LINENS

- Tablecloths: 2-3 (for different occasions/sizes)
- Cloth Napkins: 6-12 (based on number of seating)
- Table Runners: 1-2 (for different occasions)

UTILITY & OTHER ESSENTIALS

- Bath Mats: 1-2 per bathroom
- Shower Curtains: 1-2 per bathroom
- Shower Curtain Liners: 1-2 per bathroom
- Blanket Throws: 1-2 (for couches or beds).
- Mattress Protectors: 1 per bed
- Pillow Protectors: 1 per pillow
- Bedskirt: 1 per bed
- Step stool or ladder (for reaching high shelves)

ORGANIZATIONAL TOOLS

- Shelf dividers
- Storage bins or baskets
- Vacuum storage bags (for seasonal items or extra bedding)
- Over-the-door organizers
- Labels for shelves or bins

ORGANIZATION TIPS

- Labeling: Use labels or clear bins to identify where each type of linen belongs, making it easier to find and maintain order.
- Folding Techniques: Learn space-saving folding techniques to maximize shelf space and keep linens tidy.
